

Volusia-Flagler Unified Code Committee
April 19, 2007 - Meeting Recap

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 PM by Chairman Matt Adair, City of DeLand Deputy Building Official.

Items discussed:

- Request for UCC to accept Florida Spa & Pool Association option of other approved means rather than ground rod method which will meet NEC requirements of Equipotential Bonding Grid. By a majority, UCC members accepted option of other approved means without ground rods but must show how it is tied into house system
- Professional Engineers are pushing for legislative rule that will eliminate master filing altogether.
- The time and location of the May 17th UCC meeting was changed to 10:30 AM at the City of DeLand City Commission Chambers due to a scheduling conflict with a contractor licensing workshop.
- A presentation on Cooperative Effort on Emergency/Disaster Assessment was deferred as the speaker was unavailable.
- There was further discussion of initiating a system of "re-entry passes" (identification badge) for local jurisdictions' building officials/inspectors, work-crews, home/property owners, etc. following an emergency/disaster event.
- Discussion of Sign Contractor licensing and issuance of permits for electrical signs.
- The August meeting date of the UCC was rescheduled to August 23rd due to conflict with a BOAF seminar.
- There were other discussions on: potential of unified guideline on swimming pool renovations and local product approval concerns.
