

Volusia-Flagler Unified Code Committee
May 17, 2007 - Meeting Recap

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 AM by Chairman Matt Adair, City of DeLand Deputy Building Official.

Items discussed:

- Legislative Bills 404 and 2836 copies were distributed by Roy Lenois, Artesian Pools. Members discussed references to Master Planning. The Bills go into effect, if signed off by Governor Crist, on July 1, 2007
- A presentation was made on Hurricane Shelter Design. It was discussed the product needs classification and approval from the DCA. Daytona Beach Police have shown interest in the design. Concerns were expressed in reference to occupants being trapped by fallen debris during storm; also ventilation and flooding. Not for use in coastal high hazard areas/flooding.
- Roy Lenois discussed the establishment of 12 new specialty pool contractors licenses and qualification requirements [must have minimum 4 years experience; must have 3 hours of safety, business and workman's comp.; and 14 hours of continuing education]. Six testing centers have been established. The exam is done on a job site.
- Members discussed that disaster recovery entry cards-stickers would be preferable and less costly than laminated identification cards. Matt Adair will provide additional information at a future UCC meeting.
- Topic of Mobile Home Repairs was deferred to the June UCC meeting.
